



TRAVERSE OF THE JULIAN ALPS

Day 1

Arrive Ljubljana and transfer to Bohinj

Day 2

Climb Mt Vogel (1922m) to help acclimatise and get used to the terrain.

Day 3 - The Traverse Starts

Bus to Rudno Polje (1340m) and then climb through the forest, past the Vodnikov Dom (1817m refreshments), to your overnight stop at the Planika Dom (2404m) (6 hrs)

Day 4

Traverse Triglav. Ascend via Mali Triglav on a well secured route to arrive on the summit a mere 2 hrs after leaving the hut. Descend the Southern ridge of the mountain past the ruins of the Morbegna Italian Army barracks to the Dolic saddle and the Trzaska koca na Dolicu mountain hut (2151m) where you spend the night (6 hrs)

Day 5

From the Trzaska koca na Dolicu we descend

Across the Pod steno to a path junction below the Luknja saddle (1758m). We climb up from the saddle via a secured way to the summit of Bovski Gamsovec (Chamois Mountain) (2392m) we look back towards Triglav's magnificent North Face. The descent to the Pogacnikov Dom (2050m) via the Dovska vrata takes about 1hr. (Total time for the day 5½ hrs)

Day 7

A rest day in the beautiful resort town of Kranjska Gora with the opportunity to walk to the stunning viewpoint on Ciprnik (1746m)

Day 8

Transfer to Ljubljana with the option of a few hours shopping in the city before your flight

Day 6

From the Pogacnikov Dom we climb steeply to the Sedlo Planja (2349m) from where the summit of Razor (2601m) is a bare ½hr away.

The route returns to Sedlo Planja and then turns North and descends steeply to the Skrbina Notch (1995m) from where the climb towards Prisank along the Jubilee Path (built in 1953 on the 60th anniversary on the Slovenian Alpine Society) starts. We climb grassy slopes which become increasingly rocky, until we meet the exposed but well secured ledge which will take us past Zadnji okno (a natural window in the rock face) and across Zadnji Prisojnik (2392m) to the summit of Prisank (2547m). From the summit the descent takes us past the awesome Prednje okno (Front Window) a huge natural hole in the ridge with views into the Pisnica Valley. The descent to a welcome beer in the Ticarjev Dom at the top of the Vriscic road pass takes 2hrs. (Total time for the day 8hrs)
